The adult version, as portrayed in the Books of Samuel, is much more interesting – sex, betrayal, palace intrigue! Join **Rabbi Hannah Orden** as we explore the story of how the Prophet Samuel, the child born after Hannah pleaded with God, gives in to the Israelite People's demand for an earthly king. Samuel anoints Saul, but when that doesn't work out, David becomes king. The transfer of power is bloody and violent, concluding with David's dirge for Saul and his son Jonathan: "How the mighty have fallen."

We welcome special guest, **Mr. Neale Trangucci**, member of the Board of Trustees of Bridges Outreach, as well as a Core Volunteer for the organization. Through the **Bridges Outreach** program, more than 2,000 volunteers each year deliver 100,000 brown bag meals, 10,000 pairs of socks and underwear, 7,500 toiletry kits, 49,000 cups of soup, and literally tons of donated clothing to over 21,000 people in New York City, Newark and Irvington, NJ. Mr. Trangucci will talk about the needs of the homeless and how Bridges addresses those needs.
