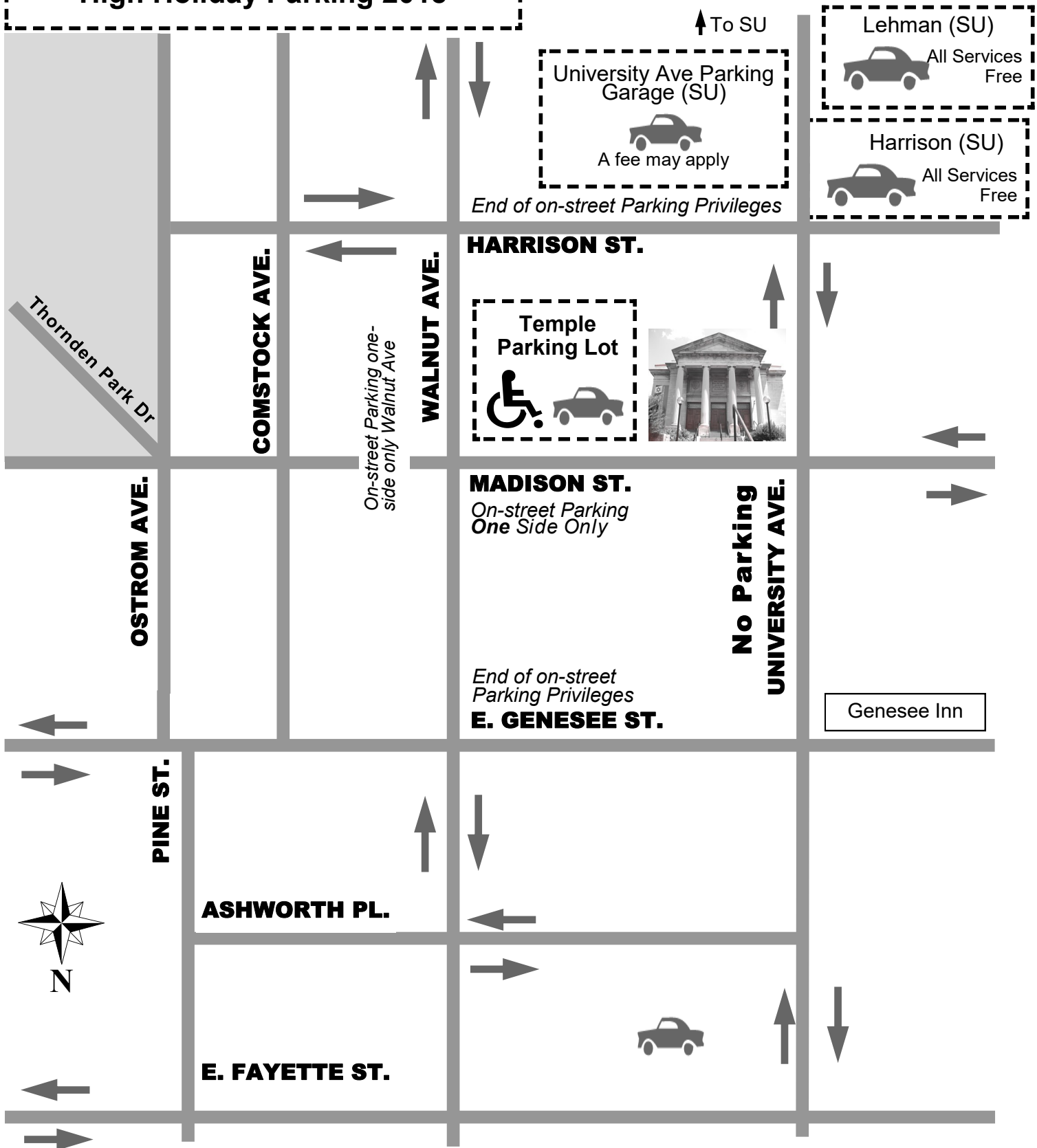


High Holiday Parking 2018

TEMPLE CONCORD HIGH HOLIDAY PARKING 2018:

Details are as follows for these locations:

◆ SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY PARKING:

Sept 1st: S'lichot Program & Service: Lehman & Harrison open lots. *No charge.*

Sept 9th: Rosh Hashanah Evening: Lehman & Harrison open lots. *No charge.*

Sept 10th & 11th Rosh Hashanah Services: University Garage. *No charge.*

Sept 18th: Kol Nidre Service: Lehman & Harrison open lots. *No charge.*

Sept 19th Yom Kippur Services: University Garage. *No charge.*

Oct 1st: Yizkor Service: Lehman & Harrison open lots. *No charge.*

It is your responsibility to let the attendant know that you are attending services at Temple Concord. We cannot reimburse for parking paid.

- ◆ **TEMPLE PARKING LOT:** Parking in the Temple lot is available on a first come basis. We encourage you to use alternative parking if you are able to allow use of the lot by those with physical limitations.

Parking in the Temple lot for Kol Nidre services is reserved for those with physical limitations. Parking is available in the SU University Ave open lots as noted above.

- ◆ **ON-STREET PARKING:** Please respect all parking restrictions as posted. Parking is prohibited in front of hydrants or too close to corners and tickets will be issued.
