
Thank you for your interest in our community!
Please follow these steps to apply for membership at Congregation Beth Shalom:

First Steps:

1. Fill out the Membership Application included in the New Member Packet.
2. Attach a photo of yourself/your family members; see flap for guidelines.
3. Return the application and photos to Beth Shalom via email, mail, fax, or in person.

Next Steps:

1. After receiving your application, Beth Shalom will contact you to set up a meeting with our Executive Director to discuss the responsibilities and opportunities of membership.
2. Your application will then be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval.
3. If accepted, you will receive a letter in the mail confirming your new status as a member of Beth Shalom.

Founded in 1968, Beth Shalom is located in Seattle's north end, the fastest growing Jewish neighborhood in the Puget Sound region. Affiliated with the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism, Beth Shalom is egalitarian in all ritual practice and attracts those with unaffiliated, Reform, and Orthodox backgrounds alike.

With a membership 400 families strong, our synagogue is a place of worship and learning for people of all ages. We are proud to maintain an intimate and informal environment.

Beth Shalom sponsors an array of Judaic classes designed to educate adults in religious life. These include programs such as the Learner's Minyan, Living Judaism, and Hebrew classes.

We also offer a scholar-in-residence series, member-led Shabbat and daily morning services, a strong hospitality program and mitzvah corps.

The religious school offers congregational education to primary and middle school students with emphasis on customs, Hebrew skills and Jewish life. Beth Shalom also has a variety of social programs for children such as our Shabbat Junior congregations, and our USY youth groups.
