#### RABBI'S MESSAGE

'shana ha'ba'ah biYerushalayim – next year in Jerusalem. These words of optimism are expressed as part of the Passover Seder, and are invoked any time a Jew wishes to say that, in the future, things will be better: L'shana Ha'ba'ah.

At last year's Seder, many of us recited those words with a renewed sense of vigor and intent. We were in the dark, early days of COVID-19, and we were being asked to make the significant sacrifice of having Seder alone. At the time, few of us believed that the pandemic would still be here by next Pesach, so we said "I'shana ha'ba'ah next year, all will be good!"

We are, generally speaking, doing better than we were last year. Of course, the individual losses suffered are devastating, but as a society we enter this Passover not in fear but with hope. Vaccines have arrived. The end is in sight. The great lesson of Jewish history is that when one says, "I'shana ha'ba'ah, next year will be better" and that prayer is not immediately answered, then we just say those words again. We never stop believing that the future will bring blessings, even if it takes a bit longer than anticipated.

Over the past year, I've heard many people say, "I wish things would just go back to normal." However, it's worth noting that the 'normal' world we left behind was far from perfect. Instead of wanting to go back, we should strive to move forward.

In Chapter 17 of Deuteronomy, the Jewish people are told, "You must not go back that way again." The medieval commentator Avraham Ibn Ezra (12th Century Spain) noted that this commandment teaches the Israelites to not return to biblical-era Egypt. Once we've left, we move forward. As we experience the miraculous wonder of a plague being slowly defeated by modern science, we look to the future with excitement. It won't be the 'normal' of the past, but it will be our 'new normal,' which will be wonderful.

t has been a year since COVID-19 came into our lives. We faced many challenges, but we accomplished even more. Our Shaar Family has remained connected in profound and meaningful ways.

The Shaar Cares Initiative, launched in response to the pandemic and supported through member donations, has become a lifeline to many vulnerable people who rely on the weekly meal deliveries.

Our operating budget was impacted by the loss of revenue from hall rentals and low school enrollment, but careful fiscal management and government subsidies allowed us to present a balanced budget for 2021 to the Finance Committee.

The architectural plans for the Chapel and the Cote-St.-Antoine lobby were presented to the congregation at the Annual General Meeting in December. The next phase of the renovations will begin in the Spring. We will soon have a new study hall, called Mercaz, which we plan to use for educational classes and learning opportunities.

I am excited to announce Shaar 2.0, an initiative funded by the Morris and Rosalind Goodman Family Foundation to enhance our online presence and to educate and inspire members of the synagogue and the community at large.

To me, as many of you know, one thing is clear: Shaar continuity goes hand in hand with Jewish continuity, and this is based on Jews feeling and knowing their roots and their manual (the Torah) for living a good life. I firmly believe that expanding our adult education programs will help guarantee Shaar continuity and will have us do our part for Jewish continuity.

I would like to thank the following people for helping me serve as your President: our esteemed Clergy for their spiritual guidance; the administrative office for their hard efforts; our security department for protecting and securing our building; our Board of Trustees for their leadership; our dedicated volunteers for their countless contributions; our members for their unwavering support; and of course, my family - my wife, Terry, our children and grandchildren, for their love and encouragement.



#### **COUNTING ONE YEAR**

Ithough we count the Jewish year from Rosh Hashanah, the Biblical year actually begins with Passover. The Torah refers to the month. of Nisan, the month of our Exodus from Egypt, as "the first month". In this way, we mark time based around the formative experience of our people, the moment when we began to understand as a collective just what being a nation is all about.

Throughout this strange year, we have instinctively referred to events in relation to the time that has passed since the start of pandemic. We remember our lives before, we have counted the months since, and we now mark this year as "year two" since our world changed. Many have suggested that this will be the formative

experience of a generation, the moment when we lost so much that was recognizable in our lives, when were forced to reevaluate and reexamine all that we took for granted.

As we enter this second pandemic Passover - and with vaccinations underway, may it be the last pandemic Passover! - This is a chance to reflect on all the ways in which we will never be the same. We now understand physical distance differently. We know that we can be far apart from one another and yet feel very intimately connected. We also understand how significant physical closeness is for our wellbeing. We recognize that how we define "community" is more important than ever, and that our values as Jews and as human beings must always be our guides. And, like the Israelites of the Exodus, we know that our children and grandchildren will be telling this story for generations to come.

### MUSIC OF THE SHAR




hat a year it has been! Who could have predicted that a full calendar year (maybe more!) would elapse between times when we could join together in person, in prayer, and in song?
