



CHALLENGES ON THE PATH TO SUCCESS

Fifty years ago – in September of 1970 – members of the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine hijacked four planes, including TWA flight 741. That flight originated in Tel Aviv and made a number of stops in Europe before heading to its intended destination of New York City.

After the flight left Frankfurt – and was flying over Belgium – the hijackers diverted the plane to Jordan. American, Israeli, and all Jewish passengers were forced to remain on board, while many others were released. Fortunately – after protracted negotiations – all of the passengers were freed. (Interestingly, it was – of all days – September 11th of that year that President Nixon announced new security regulations – such as the use of x-rays at airports – that were intended to prevent future hijackings.)

One of the passengers on TWA 741 was the great scholar Rabbi Yitchak Hutner, the longtime dean of Yeshiva Rabbi Chaim Berlin in New York and one of the leading voices of 20th Century American Orthodoxy. Rabbi Hutner was traveling with precious cargo: a manuscript for his work "Pachad Yitchak", the manuscript for the volume of his magnum opus which dealt with the festival of Shavuot.

While Rabbi Hutner survived the hijacking attempt, his manuscript did not. It was never returned to him. Months, if not years, of work were lost. However, through great effort, the book was recompiled. A lost manuscript – even if it was the only extant copy – was not enough to keep the book and its ideas from publication.

In the introduction to "Pachad Yitchak" on Shavuot, the publisher wrote of the great efforts required to produce this work. He observes that the difficult circumstances of the book's publication added to the feeling of accomplishment and joy now that it was published. What some might call "no pain, no gain" might also be couched in this way: "Without tears of sadness, there will be no tears of joy."

A similar tradition is found in the sages' description of what was contained in the Holy Ark. The Talmud (*Bava Batra* 14b) notes that the broken tablets (those shattered by Moses when he encountered the sin of the golden calf) were held alongside the second – intact – tablets. The inclusion of the broken tablets symbolizes that our challenges and failures are carried with us. This is not only a reminder of our history; rather, it's essential to our future success.

I mention these teachings because there is a tendency, as a community, to focus on the challenges, of which there are many: the challenges unique to our current political environment, the challenges of anti-Semitism, demographic challenges, financial challenges, and more. But our tradition is clear in how we encounter challenges: as opportunities. Without challenges, achievement metrics are often less fulfilling.

There is so much at the Shaar that lends to optimism: we are now in a growth phase, with upcoming renovations and expanded offerings on the horizon. It is a remarkable reality to be such a large and accomplished congregation and, at the same time, be poised for growth. On the other hand, our pushing forward does not mean that we are blind to the challenges that confront us, to the factors that work against our success. It just means that we pledge to work harder and always remember that, when confronting obstacles, the ultimate taste of success – as we realize our congregation's mission in more and more ways – is even sweeter.

Today, we have around 1350 member families.

In my opinion, if we are to have at least as many members in 20 years, the Shaar must make available classes on many Jewish topics. We must provide classes that teach Jewish basics as well as ones that uncover Judaism's most profound ideas. The goal is to fill all our rooms in the building with many classes, 7 days a week.

These classes must be engaging and well-taught, so that people leave with something to think about and talk about with their family and friends. They must come back and want to continue learning together.

Enhanced education and learning opportunities are currently being discussed among some of our committees and clergy and further planning is on the way. I hope that you will see some action soon and a more complete curriculum by the Fall. If you have topics or ideas that you would like to see in future classes, please contact me.

Finally, a Purim party is being planned, right after the Megillah reading. Come in costume, enjoy food, drinks, and music. Let's celebrate together!


