What are the dates and times for the retreat?

Check-out: Sunday, November 4, 2018 at 12:00 pm

Who is the retreat for?

Is financial aid available?

Where is Ramah Darom?

Ramah Darom is located in the beautiful North Georgia Mountains two hours north of Atlanta in Clayton, GA. Driving directions will be provided to participants.

Cabins:

All of the cabins are climatized with heat and ceiling fans. Each also includes a spacious, screened-in porch. Cabins include bed and bath linens. Cabins consist of 2 private rooms each with 2 single beds, an open area with up to 7 bunk beds, and a set of bathrooms. There are 2 separate cabins under one roof. Max: 2 families per cabin.

Standard Hotels:

Each room has 2 queen or full beds. Completely comfortable with AC and heat, tables and chairs, bureau and private bath with all linens needed. These hotels are located up a steep hill with stairs, boardwalk and walking paths to the main areas of the campus. Max: 4 people

Deluxe Hotels:

Each room has a king, 2 queen or 2 full beds. These oversized rooms are extremely comfortable with AC and heat, table and chairs, mini-fridge and a bureau. The large private bath includes linens. The rooms in the Welcome Center are an easy, flat walk to the dining hall and most indoor activities. Some connecting rooms are available. ADA accessible. Max: 4 people

Standard Hotel Room (Double Occupancy)	\$130 additional
Standard Hotel Room (Single Occupancy)	\$170 additional
Deluxe Hotel Room (Double Occupancy)	\$220 additional
Deluxe Hotel Room (Single Occupancy)	\$260 additional

If you are getting a hotel room, the additional cost is a one-time total cost, not a per person cost. So, a family of four (2 children age 10) wanting a standard hotel room will pay $\$195+\$195+\$95+\$95+\$130 = \710 .
