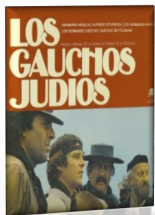
## Jewish Latino Film Series

*Anita* (2009); the dramatic story of a girl  
with Down syndrome at the time of the  
1994 AMIA bombing.



**Wednesday, April 11 @ 7:00 pm**  
*Los Abandonados/The Abandoned Ones* (2015);  
a documentary about Alberto Nisman, Chief  
Prosecutor of AMIA bombings.



**Thursday, April 12 @ 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm**  
*Wakolda/The German Doctor* (2013); an historical  
drama about Josef Mengele and an unsuspecting  
Argentinian family who hosted him.

*Mi Primera Boda/My First Wedding* (2011);
