Parshat Eikev (Pg. 980) *The Eruv is Up this Shabbat*

### Torah Insights

*And you will eat and be sated, and you shall bless the Lord, your God, for the good land He has given you (Eikev 8:10).*

The Talmud (*Berachot* 35) presents a contradiction. On one hand, the Torah declares, "To G-d is the earth and its fullness (Psalms 24:1)," implying that all of creation belongs to G-d. On the other hand, there are verses such as the aforementioned one from this week's *parsha*, which imply that the world was given over to mankind. The Talmud answers that the first verse refers to **before** one makes a *beracha*, a blessing. Prior to the recital of a blessing, that which is found in this world belongs to G-d and mankind is not granted permission to partake of it. The second verse refers to **after** the person recited the blessing. After the recitation of the blessing, mankind is granted permission to partake of G-d's creation. Hence, we see the great importance of reciting blessings prior to enjoying the fruits of this world.
