This year, **Chanukah begins on Sunday evening, December 2**, at which time we light the first candle. Please refer to the monthly bulletin for further notes on the procedure in which the candles are lit. In order to fulfill the *mitzvah*, one must use enough oil (or, for those who use them, candles that are large enough) so that the lights will burn for at least **thirty** minutes. On Friday afternoon, those who would typically use small Chanukah candles should place Shabbat candles in the *menorah*. Of course, Shabbat candles should also be lit in the usual manner, immediately after the lighting of the *menorah*.



## CHANUKAH NOTES

We recommend that you arrive at the Synagogue earlier than usual on **Friday afternoon, December 7**, to be present when the Chanukah candles are lit in the main sanctuary just prior to *Mincha*. On the first night of Chanukah, we recite three blessings upon the *menorah* (*l'hadlik ner, she'asa nissim, and she'hecheyanu*). Thereafter, we recite two blessings (*l'hadlik ner and she'asa nissim*), on each subsequent night. At Shacharit services, we recite Hallel and read the Torah each morning of Chanukah. Additionally, on **Shabbat and Sunday, December 8 and 9**, we observe *Rosh Chodesh*. Please be sure to join us.
