Parshat Pinchas (Pg. 876) *The Eruv is Up this Shabbat***

Torah Insights

Parshas Pinchas is one of the few parshiyos of the Torah in which the holidays of the year are enumerated. Their description in Parshas Pinchas is unique in that all the holiday sacrifices to be offered in the Temple are listed. The great Chassidic master, Rebbe Levi Yitchok of Bertichev, felt that it was not a coincidence that Parshas Pinchas is almost always read at the beginning of the national mourning period known as the "three weeks." For three weeks leading to the ninth day of the Hebrew month of Av, we mourn the destruction of the Temple and of Jerusalem. At the beginning of this period of national mourning, Parshas Pinchas is read to reaffirm our belief that this period of mourning is only temporary. We believe with full faith that in the near future the sacrificial orders, as described in this week's Torah reading, will be reinstated and the glory of Jerusalem will be fully restored.

SHIVA ASAR B'TAMMUZ, THE THREE WEEKS AND TISHA B'AV

The summer is marked by a three-week period in which we mourn the destruction of the First and Second Temples, as well as other tragedies suffered by our people in the course of history. The Three Weeks begin with the fast day of Shiva Asar B'Tammuz (the seventeenth of Tammuz - **Sunday, July 1**), the anniversary of the day on which the walls of Jerusalem were breached by the enemy. The Three Weeks conclude with the fast day of Tisha B'Av (the ninth of Av). This is a period of mourning during which, among other things, weddings are not celebrated and haircuts are not taken.

The mourning is intensified during the nine days immediately preceding Tisha B'Av, when it is forbidden to eat meat and drink wine, other than on Shabbat. The Nine Days begin on Rosh Chodesh Av (**Next Friday, July 13**) and, like the Three Weeks, culminate on Tisha B'Av. This year, Tisha B'Av begins on **Saturday evening, July 21**, and continues to sunset on **Sunday, July 22**.

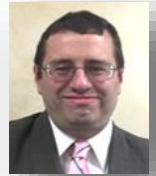
