### Torah Insights

“*And now, write for yourselves this song*” (Deuteronomy 31:19). This verse is the final mitzvah of the Torah, obligating a Jew to write his own Torah scroll. Even if he inherits a valid scroll from his parents, writes Maimonides, a Jew must still write his own. If a person is not capable of writing his own Torah, he should at least write a letter in a Torah or hire a scribe to write a Torah on his behalf. The Rosh (Rabbeinu Asher), however, adopts a controversial, if practical, approach to this 613th mitzvah. Argues this great medieval sage, the mitzvah of writing your own Torah is intended to facilitate the learning of Torah. Nowadays, since that goal is better achieved with printed Torah books, one can fulfill the final mitzvah by purchasing Torah books and setting up a personal Judaica library. On that note, you are invited to take advantage of the fully updated FAS Torah library, enriched with a wide selection of brand new Hebrew and English Torah books, geared for all levels of study.
