HOW TO APPLY FOR A NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

Now in its third year, the CBH Community is happy to offer the Matan Fund; through which families can request financial assistance with the coming year's Community School tuition. This fund is supported through directed giving.

Please note that need-based scholarships are limited to members in good standing of CBH. Prior to submitting a scholarship application, each family is responsible for confirming their financial standing and arranging an adjustment to their membership dues with the Executive Director, Treasurer, or VP of Finance as necessary.

Much consideration was given as to how to equitably distribute the funds while maintaining an atmosphere of respect, dignity and privacy. All applications will be anonymous to The Matan Fund Committee. The Committee will base its decisions on the following factors:

- The level of support requested (*amount the family can afford to contribute, unique financial situation as expressed in narrative question*)
- Commitment to CBH (*amount of time as members, volunteer service at school, shul committees or other projects*)
- The family's commitment to the Jewish education of their child(ren).

Applications must be submitted by July 30, 2014.

Recipients of the need-based scholarship will be required to support our community programs by volunteering in the school and/or CBH community throughout the year.
