



Journey Program “*Madrichim*”

***High Schoolers who want Volunteer Credit Hours**

Journey, the Jewish Discovery Project is the religious education program of Congregation Shma Koleinu (CSK). CSK is a Houston-based synagogue without walls that seeks to serve all Jews, Jewish families and those who love them with meaningful Jewish life opportunities for spirituality, education, and community connection. Because CSK doesn't own or occupy a building of its own, we utilize rental venues. **Journey, our education program for children 4 years old through 7th grade, this year will take place in the ERJCC ground floor classrooms on Sunday mornings, from 9:45 am – 12:00 pm, starting October 3rd.**

Journey is looking for motivated *Madrichim* (counselors) to work on Sunday mornings in our very informal (Montessori-type) education program. The work involved would include:

1. Arriving to Journey by 9:00 am to help with set up and prep.
2. Familiarizing oneself each week with the “Jewish values-centered program plan” of the day, to be able to help teach and lead the children.
3. Participating in the close-up and clean-up of Journey each Sunday, departing by 12:30 pm (or as soon as all supplies are picked up and put away).
4. Madrichim familiar with basic Hebrew reading is a plus but not a necessity.

Compensation: 4 Volunteer Hours for each Sunday
