

## Outdoor In Person Gatherings at Adath Israel:

These are general guidelines to be followed for in person outdoor gatherings at Adath Israel during the covid 19 pandemic. However, a plan for the gathering must be submitted to the Executive Director for review and approval.

General principles and policies regarding attendance at AI events during covid remain in place and are reiterated here:

- All guests/visitors/staff
  - Have no recent symptoms of covid (fever, shortness of breath, dry cough, persistent headache, loss of taste or smell)
  - Have not tested positive for covid in past 10 days
  - Have had no contact within the past 10 days with someone testing positive for covid (or if greater than 10 days ago had a negative covid test on day 5 post exposure)
  - If recently traveled, have followed Pennsylvania most current guidelines and have either completed quarantine or had a negative covid test.

Appropriate space for outdoor gatherings will be determined by number of people in attendance, while allowing for separation of households by at least 6 feet.

- As an example, the courtyard could host up to 50 people with no food service and up to 35 people with food service depending on the number of household units (will be reviewed after plan submitted as noted above)
- Front lawn/parking lot ... should be used for events with expected larger attendance.

Places where lines are possible/likely will be marked with signs as reminders for social distancing, as examples:

- Entrance/Exit – for events taking place in the courtyard or any other place with a single or narrow entrance participants must follow social distancing.
- Food service – i.e. a food truck or table for food service.

Food service outdoors:

Events such as a Bar/Bat Mitzvah or Wedding reception:

- Preferred individually boxed/plated meals for people
- Plans for individual flatware packaging
- For buffet style meal a server must be hired –
  - Server must be masked and gloved at all times and is the only person permitted to serve food.
  - All food distribution for food service tables is to be by household unit individually called up.

Food truck outside vendor:

- Households to approach individually and remain distanced in line

- Masks required while in line
- Preorders preferred to decrease wait time
- Meals taken to designated eating area – spaced 6 feet for when masks to be removed during eating.

Eating:

- Masks may be removed for the purpose of eating or drinking
- All eating/drinking will take place in assigned area (table/blanket etc) and designated areas will be grouped by household.

Bathroom use: Appropriate doors will be kept open for use of the restrooms during any event; use will be limited to an individual (or 2 from a single household i.e parent and child).
