Smichas Chaver Program

One of the greatest zechuyos that a person can accept is kabalos hatorah. I strongly encourage the oilam to join us and learn practical halacha as we will be learning one more zman of hilchos shabbos. The Chofetz Chaim writes that in the zechus of keeping hilchos shabbos properly one achieves mechila on all his sins as the pasuk states Shomer Shabbos meichallo - read it machul lo. The Mishna Berura stresses the need to know halacha as a prerequisite to Shmiras Shabbos. The Passuk states lada'as chachma umusaar. Only through chochmas hatorah can we achieve mussar. He quotes Hagoan Rav Yonasan Eibishitz that it is impossible to keep Shabbos properly without learning these halachos. We will be learning the Halachos of amira leikum (interaction with the gentile on Shabbos). I want to invite everyone to join beginning Sunday evenings after Sukkos b'ezras Hashem Yisbarach. May all of our Torah be a zechus for your families and klal Yisrael.
