- Dislike writing, coloring or cutting paper?
- Have difficulty with puzzles and construction?
- Have difficulty putting on shoes, socks, or zipping up a jacket?
- Have noise and smell sensitivity such as those in a restaurant or mall?
- Seem clumsy or always seem a beat behind?
- Seem to fatigue faster than their peers?
- Seem to need extra movement, lack impulsive control, and intrude in other people's space?
- Seem to have tantrums that are longer and more intense than others?
- Seem to have trouble entering a group of friends to play?

Social Skills Class

Social skills may not always come naturally. Our goal is to help children learn about their thoughts and feelings, recognize a group plan, think with their eyes, keep their bodies in the group, and use whole-body listening.

Children further refine their skills as they learn about hidden rules and unexpected behaviors, make smart guesses, recognize the difference between flexible and stuck thinking, determine the size of a problem, and share their imaginings.
