

Pursuant to our Constitution and By-Laws, the following conditions must be met and procedures followed to nominate an individual by petition to the congregation at large.

- Article 10 Section 2: NOMINATION BY PETITION: Nomination for any office or Trustee may be made by petition of any twenty five members of the Congregation.
- Article 10 Section 3 Subdivision 2: Nominations by petition by the Congregation at large must be filed with the Chairperson of the Nominating Committee by giving same to the Chairperson of the Nominating Committee at least two weeks prior to the election, and notice of all nominations must be given to the Congregation at least ten days before the election.
- Article 10 Section 3 Subdivision 3: No nomination shall be valid unless accompanied by the written or oral consent of the nominees to stand for the office or trusteeship in question.
- Any nomination by petition must be submitted to the HIR office att: Mark Baker, Chair Nominating Committee no later than June 14, 2016
