JEWISH HERITAGE TOURS: Rabbi Lookstein Leads July Mission to Berlin/Prague (or Berlin Only – your choice).

Rabbi Haskel Lookstein once again teams-up with beloved Ramaz Faculty alumnus Dr. David Bernstein as the “Dynamic Duo” of Jewish heritage tours, but this July they soar to Berlin/Prague (a Berlin Only option is available). Berlin and Prague sit at the crossroads of modern Jewish history. Many of the themes of contemporary Judaism began here: the struggle with assimilation, the division into movements, the search for a homeland, and the battle against anti-Semitism.
