

The Rabbis taught that God chanted the Torah to Moses at Sinai, and that Moses began the tradition of transmitting the music of the Torah through the generations. "In Exodus 19:19 we read, '[God] answered [Moses] with a voice.' This means Moses received [and transmitted] the melodies of the Torah that he heard from God". (*Yalkut Yitro*, quoted in Jacobson, Chanting the Hebrew Bible)
