## FROM THE DESK OF RABBI RAVSKI

This space is often used as a place of teaching Torah, of speaking to the moment or the holiday coming in the month ahead. While Tu B'Shvat, a minor holiday that celebrates the onset of spring in Jerusalem, falls at the start of February, I am choosing to use this space this month for a different type of Torah, to speak a little about a particular lifecycle event, professional development and how I, and ultimately Synagogue Emanu-El, is playing a key role in the future of the Conservative Movement.

The lifecycle event is divorce. Often we overlook this difficult moment, in part because of the difficult nature of the moment and also because unlike birth, bnai mitzvah, or death, it is not something that will happen to us all. It is however, one of the most consequential lifecycle moments by those who do experience it.

From a Jewish perspective, the dissolution of a marriage is always a possibility. The very document that sanctifies a Jewish marriage, the ketubah, is more akin to a prenuptial agreement than it is anything else. In that document, the parties promise to love and care for each other financially and emotionally, but it also provides an outline for what is owed in spousal support should the marriage dissolve. Jewish law also requires that when a couple gets married, the marriage can only be performed based on the laws of the land, in other words, the couple has to be married both in the eyes of the civil authorities and Judaism, they can not just have a religious ceremony if they are not also legally married. This process is mirrored at the end of a marriage as well, once the civil divorce is complete, the couple also needs to divorce religiously. This Jewish divorce is done through a document called a Get.

Without a Get, the two individuals are still connected to one another in Judaism. This of course can complicate any future relationships they have, or the relationship they have with their former spouse, who they are religiously still married too.

A Get, and the process of divorce through a Jewish lens, is meant to bring sacred closure to a chapter of the lives of the individuals involved. It is a serious ritual moment, which can be painful but can also bring relief. The ritual is meant to offer support and care for both spouses, and while we may not publicize it as we do any other lifecycle events, it is taken just as, if not more seriously than any other moment. One of the most unique aspects of a Get, is that it can not be written by just anyone, as a ketubah can. A Get, can only be written by a Messader Gittin, a scribe of Gets. It must be written with the same ink as a Torah Scroll is written, and with a quill. The style of writing is specific to the ritual, and the way the Hebrew is written is a variation on the calligraphy used to write a Torah.

Being a Messader Gittin is highly skilled and specialized training, so much so that the Conservative Movement has not trained any new ones in over fifteen years. This is where Emanu-El comes into the picture. In January 2021, I was honored to have been selected as a member of the next cohort to receive this training. The course to train Mesaddrei Gittin involves in-depth study of the laws related to Jewish divorce. For two years I have been engaged in a professional development program of intensive weekly study of Talmudic learning and discussion. This past January, I spent a week in New York for the first of two in-person learning sessions where we will continue to study the laws and codes, debate real-life situations, and learn both the pastoral and scribal skills necessary for facilitating a kosher Jewish divorce. This ancient process, brought into modern Jewish life, is essential for the continuation of our Jewish communities. To be part of this new cohort of about 20 Rabbis throughout North America is a true honor and I am humbled by the responsibility. I am also grateful to the Emanu-El community and leadership for the opportunity to receive this training, one which will ultimately allow me to be one of two rabbis in the southeast who can facilitate and write a Get for those who need them.




