RABBINIC INTERN-ILIANA BRODSKY

Have you ever sat with a child and counted rings on a stump? It can feel like magic that trees mark the passage of time in the same way we do. How do they know that we've made another turn around the sun? What else do we share with trees? Our inextricable connection to the natural world is a foundational part of Jewish Tradition. Soon we'll celebrate Tu b'Shvat, the birthday of the trees, a holiday which emerged from our agricultural past. In Leviticus chapter 19 verses 23-25 we are told that when we enter the land and begin to plant trees for ourselves, we are forbidden from harvesting their fruits for three years. The crops of the fourth year are to be tithed, and not until the fifth year are we allowed to derive benefit from the fruit. As society developed, the question arose of how to count an agricultural year so that farmers could uphold these laws. The rabbis decided on the 15th (Tu) of Shevat, reasoning that by then, most of the season's rain had fallen and the land would be best suited for new planting.

I'm not quite sure why God commands us to wait five years before enjoying the fruits of our trees. Five is not a particularly common or holy number in the Torah. Five is, however, an important age for Jewish children. In rabbinic literature, even though a person is not obligated until they are b'nei mitzvah age, we see cases where our sages deem it fit for a child to start taking on very simple action-based mitzvot, like listening to Shofar and sitting in a Sukkah, at five years old. By age five, they assume, a child has acquired enough independence and awareness to participate, even if only in some small way, in our communal practices. I am taken by this shared developmental timeline. Just as we wait five years before a child is spiritually and physically capable of performing acts which nourish our community, so too we wait five years before we derive nourishment from our trees. Tu b'Shvat reminds us that God created us to be in profound relationship with all the natural world. The rabbis understood this connection, and recognized mitzvot as the fruits of our being; requiring time and intention to develop, to nourish. It has become a tradition for Jews to try a new fruit on Tu b'Shvat as part of the holiday ritual. In honor of fostering this connection we have to trees, I urge you to also take on a new mitzvah this year- one that you'll find soul nourishing. Maybe you'd like to say Modeh Ani when you first wake up in the morning, to start your day off in a place of gratitude. Perhaps you're feeling disconnected from your community, and want to pay a visit to someone who's sick, or show up for someone saying kaddish. My relationship to food has changed a lot since becoming a full-time student. I eat way too many meals at my desk, or out of a plastic package. This year I'm committed to saying more blessings over food, to reestablish a level of intentionality around eating that feels right for me. I'm so excited to be with y'all in Charleston for Tu b'Shvat and to hear which mitzvot you're needing in your lives, which fruits you're ready to harvest. Until then, I'm wishing you all nothing but peace and light in the New Year.

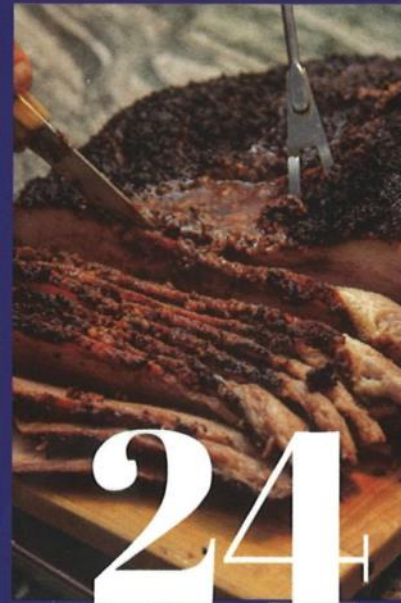
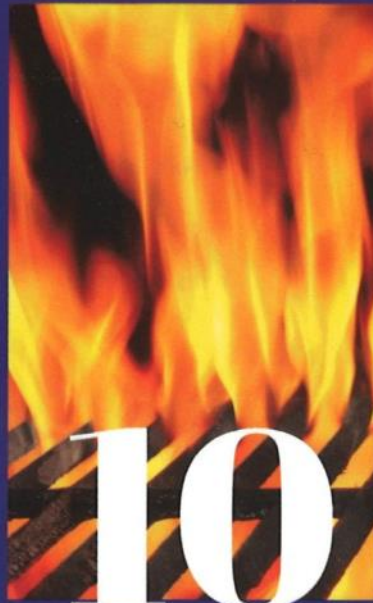
