Who are the Abayudaya?

The Abayudaya are the People of Judah founded by Semei Kakungulu.

Rabbi Samsom Mogombe is one of the first disciples of Semei Kakungulu. Semei Kakungulu was a warrior and hunter who helped British colonists who wanted to convert him to Christianity. He was drawn to the Old Testament. In 1919, he declared himself a Jew. He circumcised himself and his children.

Rabbi Mogombe was one of his first disciples in the 1920's. They helped build a community that grew to 5000 Jews.

Idi Amin almost wiped out the Abayudaya; their numbers dwindled to 500. Once Idi Amin was deposed, they grew to the 2000 Jews today.

Rabbi Gershon Sizomu, Aaron Moses' brother-in-law, is their current spiritual leader. He was trained at the Ziegler Institute in California.

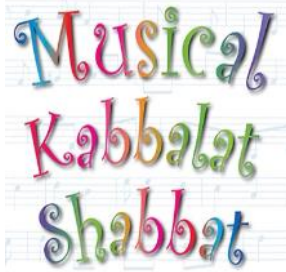
