MINYAN NOTES:

Mask and Social Distancing Rules:

Indoors :

- Masks REQUIRED for all individuals (adults and children) inside the building whether attending services, groups or hanging out - even for those who have been vaccinated.

In the tent:

- Masks are optional, but we recommend that ALL individuals wear masks.

- We ask that you maintain 3 feet of social distancing from individuals not in your household.

Masks supplied by YIWP:

The masks supplied by YIWP are reusable, washable and intended for those who have forgotten their masks. Please try to remember to bring your masks when coming to shul. As a suggestion, one can leave these masks in their Tallis bags, shoe bags, coat pockets, etc. so as not to waste numerous masks.

General Rules:

- Sign up is still REQUIRED in order to help with capacity planning and contact tracing for shabbat minyanim. Signup is no longer required for weekday minyanim.

- You may use shul siddurim/chumashim. We ask that you return them to the shelf when you are done.

GENERAL REMINDERS:

- Do not attend minyan if you are feeling sick, have fever or other symptoms associated with COVID.

- Do not attend minyan if you've been exposed to someone with COVID and are required to Quarantine.
