This Week at YIWP:

Gil Tamary - "Beresheet, the Israeli spacecraft to the moon" - May 11 following Mussaf

Gil covered the "Beresheet" journey extensively, and will share his first-hand experience. It is an incredible story that captures the Israeli spirit, innovation, courage, Chutzpah and resilience.

Gil Tamary is the Washington bureau chief for Israel's Channel 10 News, and he is known by virtually every Israeli as a top news reporter. He has worked for Israel Broadcasting Authority, Israel Public Radio, and as anchor and chief editor of "Good Morning Israel." Gil covers a wide range of Middle East issues from the U.S. and conducts exclusive interviews with many dignitaries and political figures, including presidents, secretaries of State, the head of the World Bank and others.

Also known for his reporting on the Israeli economy, Gil used to serve as International Editor of Forbes - Israel magazine, and Economic editor for Israel TV and the IDF radio and was a writer for "Globes", Israel's #1 business newspaper.

Gil has an MBA degree from Tel Aviv University, and a BA degree with distinction in Economics and Management (also) from Tel Aviv University.

His family made aliya to Israel in the 1880's in the first Zionist immigration wave and established two of the first Jewish "Moshavot" in the Galilee. Gil is a reserve officer in the IDF.
