It is with a heavy heart that we join all of Am Yisrael in mourning the loss of Ari Fuld z"l, a powerful advocate for Israel who was murdered by a terrorist while shopping in a

supermarket on Sunday, in Gush Etzion. Ari heroically managed to shoot his attacker and prevent him from killing others.

Our deepest condolences go to Ari's wife, Miriam, their four children, his parents Rabbi and Mrs. Yonah Fuld, his four brothers, and the SAR community. His family members spoke at his funeral, describing him as a hero, fearless fighter, teacher, lover and defender of the land of Israel, and passionate about Torah.
