### **Minyan Notes:**

**Please be on time for all minyanim so that we can start with a minyan and finish on time.**

### **Adjusting to the new NYS/CDC Rules:**

There have been a few changes issued by the CDC and NYS regarding the rules surrounding religious services - including some released over Shavuot. While we are still evaluating these changes, we have decided that we will make the following changes starting with Mincha on Thursday 5/20/21:

- **Signup is still required**
- **Masks are still required for ALL those that are attending indoor minyanim over the age of 2.**

**All minyanim in the Tent will be mask optional - provided:**

**You are fully vaccinated (2 weeks or more beyond your final shot)**

**You can only remove your mask if you are NOT sitting under the tent canopy (i.e. you've taken a chair in the parking lot)**

**If you are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated (i.e. you have either only received 1 dose of a 2-dose vaccine, or less than 2 weeks have passed since your final dose) you need to wear a mask at outdoor minyanim as well.**

**To provide more room for people to sit outside the tent, please do not park adjacent to the tent.**

We will be conducting a full slate of youth groups, they will take place in the social hall and in the parking lot (please see the details elsewhere in this e-mail)

Please maintain social distancing from all congregants that are not part of your immediate household.

If you do take a chair out of the tent, please return the chair to the tent after davening is over.

If you are not feeling well, or are awaiting the results of a COVID test or have a family member with COVID, please do not come to shul.

## **Quarantine Rules for Guests and Travelers**

### **For Domestic Travelers:**

- As of April 1st, NYS has ended the quarantine requirement for domestic travelers regardless if you were vaccinated or not.

### **For International Travelers:**

- You are required to quarantine for 10 days after arrival in the US

- You can shorten your quarantine to 7 days if you have a negative PCR Test if you test negative. The test must be taken from 3-5 days after you arrive.

- If you are fully vaccinated (14 days after your final shot) we ask that you obtain a negative PCR test between 3-5 days of arriving before coming to shul
