Shabbat Rosh Hashanah

DAVENING REMINDERS

1. Everyone over the age of 2 MUST wear a face mask or face covering over their mouths and noses at all times while at shul
2. If you have your own Machzor please bring it to shul with you
3. The seats have been set up and assigned to allow for proper social distancing. Please DO NOT move any chairs in the Tent or Social Hall, and only sit in your designated seats in the main sanctuary.
4. Keep at least 6 feet of distance between other congregants.
5. Do not shake hands.
6. Refrain from loud and spirited singing.
7. Do not leave any personal belongings (e.g. tallit, kippot etc.) at Shul or under the tent.
8. Do not hold or touch the Torah.
9. No ball playing or running around in parking lot.
10. All children who attend services must be seated for the entire service.
11. Hand sanitizers will be placed at stations throughout the shul and outside.
12. There will be very limited parking in the parking lot over Yom Tov. Please do not drive to shul on Friday night if you do not need to.

Machzorim - If you would like to borrow a machzor from the shul, a limited number will be available. On the first day, there will be a table with machzorim on it. Please take the machzor home with you and bring it back the second day. Please leave the machzor on the table when you leave on the second day. Please do not forget to return it.
