MINYAN NOTES:

In consultation with our medical team, and in light of recent updates by the CDC and NYS DOH we have revised our rules regarding masks and social distancing (If you have any questions or concerns about this, please feel free to reach out to Yonah Wolf, Moshe Mirsky, or a member of the medical team).

Mask and Social Distancing Rules:

Indoors :

- Because of the Surge in Corona Virus Cases in Westchester County, we are reinstating

the Masking Requirement FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS attending indoor services - even for those who have been vaccinated.

In the tent:

- Masks are optional, but we recommend that ALL individuals wear masks.
- We ask that you maintain 3 feet of social distancing from individuals not in your household.

General Rules:

- Sign up is still REQUIRED in order to help with capacity planning and contact tracing.
- You may use shul siddurim/chumashim, we ask that you return them to the shelf when you are done.

GENERAL REMINDERS:

- Do not attend minyan if you are feeling sick, have fever or other symptoms associated with COVID
- Do not attend minyan if you've been exposed to someone with COVID and are required to Quarantine
