Dear Temple Community:

In this edition of the Pathfinder, I want to give you a brief update on what we have accomplished with regard to annual savings for our community. I also want to direct you to the financial report I mentioned we would be posting. The first edition of this report, which is currently live on Shulcloud, is a snapshot of our full annual results for fiscal 2017/2018. We hope you find it useful and enlightening.

On the savings front, I am happy to report that, with the help of our dedicated staff and board volunteers, we accomplished annualized savings of approximately \$35,540. These savings come primarily from changes and/or negotiations with several of our vendors. For example, landscaping, phones, Internet service and others. We also moved to a paperless billing and online registration system which produced significant cost reductions. We will, of course, continue to look for other opportunities.
