**Rabbi Berel Wein** has served as Morah d'Atrah of the Beit Knesset Hanassi in the Rechavia neighborhood of Jerusalem for over 20 years. Under his inspirational leadership, our community has grown and become a flourishing addition to the city of Jerusalem. We now have over 400 members and a full educational program, including a morning Kollel and courses of stimulating shiurim for men and women every day of the week. We have three minyanim on Shabbat where we welcome hundreds of overseas visitors throughout the year. To commemorate 20 years of dedicated service to our community, and in recognition of his enormous contribution to Jewish education, the community has decided to honor Rabbi Wein by writing a new Sefer Torah, which will be housed in our beautiful Jerusalem shul, and by launching the Rabbi Berel Wein Jewish History Scholarship Program.

Rabbi Berel Wein made Aliyah from the United States to Israel in 1997 and soon afterwards became Rabbi of Beit Knesset Hanassi Yisrael Hatzair. He has been involved in community leadership and Jewish education for over fifty years and his incomparable teachings have spread across the globe. In addition to serving as the Rabbi of three different communities in the US, he was Executive Vice President of the Orthodox Union. He is a highly knowledgeable, articulate, and entertaining educator and a prolific author, whose wisdom is appreciated and sought after by Jews all over the world. Rabbi Wein established the Destiny Foundation to share his love of Jewish history. He brings a rare historical perspective to the Torah world, which he disseminates through his educational CDs, audio tapes, books and film projects.

**We plan to honor Rabbi Wein's unique contribution to Jewish scholarship through the writing of a new Sefer Torah, and through the establishment of a Jewish History Scholarship Program. Please help us with a generous donation towards these two projects.**

The Rabbi Berel Wein Jewish History Scholarship Program will encourage the learning and teaching of Jewish History. We hope to raise sufficient funds through this appeal campaign to fund scholarships for three students on a continuous basis, in addition to the writing of the Sefer Torah.
