

## KIDDUSH REPORT 2020

Kiddush is prepared by our wonderful volunteers, who are often joined by Bar/Bat Mitzvah (BM) families, who generally help for 4 duties before their child's BM. BM's either take place during a Shabbat morning service or during an afternoon service, so quite often volunteers are needed for both the morning and afternoon.

When celebrating a BM, or another special occasion, families now have the option to supplement the kiddush with platters of bagels, at an extra cost, the uptake of which has been high.

We are now using RotaCentral for our Kiddush rota, which before lockdown, seemed to be working smoothly. We have now given the BM parents the opportunity to decide between themselves which Shabbat's they would like to help out at, which has made the rota process work more smoothly.

Hopefully at some point in the future we will be back in the shul and be able to have Kiddush, and would therefore welcome new volunteers who could join us for 45 minutes before the service and half an hour or so afterwards.

As always a big thank you to our volunteers for their hard work in preparing the Kiddush and for making sure everything is clean and tidy once Kiddush is finished.
