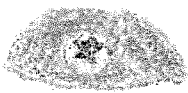
Dear Karin

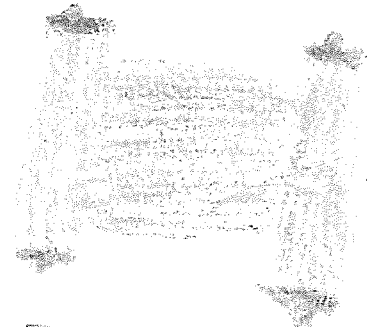

Thank you so much for arranging a visit to the synagogue for my school. I really enjoyed the visit.

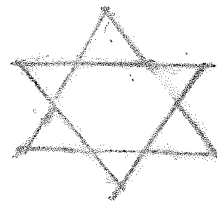
It was interesting to learn about the Jewish faith. I liked to learn about the scrolls and wearing the Kippah.

Thank you for sharing your time with us.

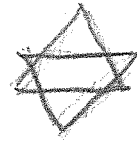

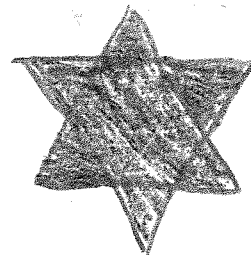
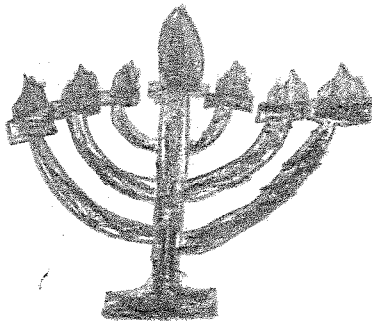
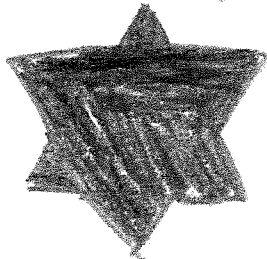
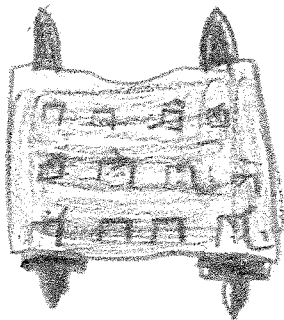
Dear Karin,
