REMINDER: Halacha (the law) requires that **MEZUZOS** be checked and examined every 3 1/2 years or twice in 7 years. Temperature, humidity, as well as age may cause the ink to fade and crack, thereby invalidating the mezuzah. Info: Rabbi Nathan Allweiss, 718-997-8438
