BETH JULIE

There is a simple 4 letter word to describe the essence of Beth Julie. And that word would be

LOVE.

Beth was born in Queens, N.Y. and raised in Marlboro, New Jersey, at a time when Marlboro had very little Jewish community of which to speak.

Her family belonged to Congregation Beth Ohr, a small fledgling synagogue in Old Bridge. Her father decided that if the synagogue was going to be viable it would need to begin with the youngest of members. So he organized a Hebrew School for the synagogue, which Beth attended 3 times a week. While her family identified with the Conservative movement, there was flexibility in practice and in adherence. Beth had a Friday night Bat Mitzvah at the age of thirteen during which she chanted the haftarah taught to her by her father. She explains, "He had a gorgeous voice and davened beautifully" (an inherited talent - his mother had been a professional singer).

Beth continued her involvement in Jewish community life post-bat mitzvah through USY. She was surrounded by commitment to Judaism at home. Her mother lit candles and made Shabbat dinner every Friday night. Her father chanted a magnificent Kiddush. The family attended Friday night services together at Beth Ohr- the synagogue where her father founded the Hebrew school and served as president of the board of trustees. However, as a student at Trenton State College, her involvement in Jewish life waned.

In addition to her parents, Beth credits her maternal grandmother as having the most influence on her life. As a child, she spent a tremendous amount of time with her grandmother and experienced the richness of receiving unconditional love.

Beth describes the moment of revelation when she realized the importance of Jewish community involvement. Her paternal grandfather had died and her father said kaddish for him every day. When her concerned father anxiously wondered who would be able or willing to say Kaddish for him like he had for his father, Beth was struck by the intensity and meaning of that concern, and the simple question marked the road back to Jewish life.

Soon thereafter, on her first trip to Israel, she met Ed Julie. They were married one year later almost to the day and went back to Israel for their honeymoon!

While the importance of a commitment to Jewish life had already been set into action, it was the pregnancy with her first child that solidified it. Ed and Beth made a decision that would alter her life, and ultimately Shomrei Torah's. The Julie's decided to have a kosher home and when their children were ready, they would go to day school. Her son Cory was born in 1985, daughter Jacquelyn followed in 1986 and the Julie family moved to Wayne where Benjamin made his appearance in 1989. Even before her first child was born, Beth was involved in the Gerrard Berman Day School which all her children attended, followed by upper school at the now Golda Och Academy in West Orange.

Searching out the Conservative synagogue in Wayne, Beth instantly felt a kindred spirit in Rabbi Segelman and the Julie's became members of Shomrei Torah.

Anyone who knows Beth, knows that she is in perpetual motion and she will be the first to agree that she has very little spare time and that is just the way she wants it! As she shared: "I am really bad at relaxing". She is an avid hiker, a pastime that she thoroughly enjoys with her husband, Ed. She loves to travel and has made a personal goal to see as many wonders of the world as she can. (She's already made a dent in that list, Petra in Jordan, the Grand Canyon, Iguaza Falls in Argentina, and the Pyramids in Giza.)

In the scope of the wider Jewish community, Beth feels a responsibility to strive to act in a certain way that represents the ideals of Judaism. Part of that ideal is to teach joy as an integral spiritual element of Judaism and she would love to see that joy translated into Shomrei Torah services. She would love to see music used as a way to connect with people throughout the service and to bring traditional bible stories to life through music and other creative outlets. In looking at the larger picture, Beth explains, "if the kids enjoy it, then parents will enjoy it. Instill when they are little and as they get older, the spirit remains."

As for herself, Judaism is the moral and ethical code by which she strives to structure her life. It is a roadmap to help her navigate life's experiences and offers the moral fiber through which to extract its lessons. However, the one lesson that governs all is the one that her grandmother showed: The value of love. Pure, unconditional, no strings attached, love.



ED JULIE

As a child of Holocaust survivors who escaped the war by fleeing east to Siberia Ed Julie grew up in the Bronx speaking only Yiddish until age 5. His father lived in multiple countries and speaks nine languages and his mother emigrated from the Ukraine and worked in a sweat shop in NYC to make ends meet.

A graduate of Bronx High School of Science and Cornell University, Ed attended Albert Einstein College of Medicine with Honors in 1980 and spent his residency at

Mount Sinai Hospital and a cardiology fellowship at New York Hospital-Cornell Medical Center.

He began private practice in Clifton, NJ in July 1986 with Beth as his "heart and soul". He explains "I was the doctor. Beth was everything else". Together the business grew to five cardiologists and four offices. In 2013 the practice was sold to the Valley Medical Group, Valley Hospital. This has been a wonderful transition for both the Julies; for Ed who enjoys working for a strong institution with state of the art physicians and services and Beth recently retired from the practice to pursue her other interests. But as Ed states "I miss her friendship and guidance in the office".

Ed lectures extensively, both locally and throughout the East Coast on Hypertension (High Blood Pressure) and Dyslipidemia (High Cholesterol). He also does a great deal of consulting work on medical-legal cases and has become a leading defense Cardiology expert in NJ.

An active person, he exercises regularly four times per week and he and Beth are avid hikers and have taken fantastic hiking trips in Montana, Wyoming, Nevada and in Alberta (Canadian Rockies). Ed is also a passionate Giants fan, holding season tickets for the past 30 years.

He and Beth love to travel and they have traveled extensively throughout the US, Canada, the Caribbean, Europe, Central and South America. Their favorite place is Israel where he and Beth first met in 1980. One year later they were back in Israel on their honeymoon! They feel a spiritual connection to Jerusalem and go to the Old City and Kotel as much as possible. They recently joined Congregation Moreshet Yisrael, the Conservative Synagogue in Jerusalem and have davened there on Shabbat as well as on Chag Pesach. Beth has chanted Haftarat there and Ed has led Shacharit.

The Julies joined Shomrei Torah shortly after moving to Wayne in 1986. Ed loves the "Hamish" feeling of a small group of regular Shul goers who have become their second family. He enjoys the continuous opportunities to lead services and chant Haftarat and feels the most spiritual connection while leading Shacharit Services during Rosh Hashanah. He says "The feeling is truly indescribable, and I love having my family in Shul on those days". Both he and Beth have developed a strong connection to Rabbi Mark and it is Ed's wish that as he works less in the future, he will have more of an opportunity to learn Torah and Jewish History with the Rabbi.

Nothing is more important to the Julie family than their children. Their oldest son, Cory, who received his PhD in International Government from Georgetown one year ago is engaged. The Julies are beyond excited that the aufruf will be at Shomrei Torah! Cory's fiancée Miriam Ganem-Rosen, is a wonderful young woman who has already led Friday night services here at Shomrei Torah. Their daughter, Jackie, lives in NYC with her boyfriend Mark, and amongst other things is currently editing a Rabbinical Kabbalistic Manuscript. Their youngest son Ben, speaks multiple languages, tutors Hebrew, Italian and Spanish, and is currently exploring startup opportunities in the field of novel Language Learning Methodology. There is nothing Ed likes better than to have all of his kids home for Shabbat dinner with their respective significant others.

Ed hopes that Shomrei Torah grows into a thriving, successful Institution with a younger demographic, a fully subscribed Hebrew School/Hebrew High and an exceptional complement of youth and Adult ED Programming. In the future, he hopes to be able to take a more active role in attaining these goals.

Ed elaborates on what being Jewish means to him: "Being Jewish is a life choice for me. It means being the best person that I can be. It means treating my fellow human beings with respect and compassion, and always being there in someone else's time of need. It means establishing and maintaining a spiritual connection with Hashem through davening and leading prayer services. It means giving Tzedakah and helping those less fortunate. It means taking care of my family, wife, children and aging parents." Ed credits his wife Beth with living a life that has taught him the very values by which he strives to live. He declares, "She is glowing example of "mentschlichkeit".
