Make a contribution of \$360 or more towards the purchase and planting of a tree on our Synagogue's lawn and a marker will be placed by the tree memorializing your gift. But a contribution of any amount will be acknowledged with a special certificate of recognition. Give the gift of a tree in memory of a loved one, the birth of a new baby or any meaningful occasion.

Earlier this year we lost several mature trees planted along the sidewalk next to Hinchman Avenue. Over the years these trees had grown to conflict with PSE&G overhead power lines. For years PSE&G had been pruning part of the trees closest to its wires, leaving undisturbed only the limbs that extended toward our building. This pruning resulted in structurally weak and unstable trees.

PSE&G cut these trees down at its own expense. It left us with the task of grinding down the stumps, which we already have done. Our next step is to plant grass in dirt areas where the grinding took place.

If you were accustomed to seeing the trees, our site might now look sparse. So we would like to replace them. Some (but not all) of the cost of replacement trees may be borne by a grant from Passaic County and DigIn, a County environmental contractor. But we'll still need additional funds.

Don't worry. The new trees won't grow so tall as to interfere with the wires, and will be planted far away from them.
