GUIDE TO PARKING FOR THE HIGH HOLIDAYS

Street parking is available for the High Holidays. **Please note that the 5 spots in front of TBH are reserved.** DO NOT PARK IN OTHER LOTS DURING THE DAY ON WEEKDAYS AS YOU MAY BE TOWED—THIS INCLUDES THE LOT DIRECTLY ADJACENT TO THE TEMPLE AS WELL AS NEIGHBORING LOTS.

We have made arrangements with the city of Olympia to use the street parking without having to feed the meter. If you park at a metered spot, place the “Attending High Holiday Religious Services” placard (the opposite side of this sheet) face up on the dashboard. This will be in effect Monday, September 30 (Rosh Hashanah, Day 1) and Wednesday, October 9 (Yom Kippur). Parking Services has advised our attendees to park within a two block radius of the temple.

Use of carpools and public transportation is encouraged. TBH is four blocks from the Olympia Transit Center, one block from a stop on the #60 and #64 bus lines (on 8th near the library) and one block from a stop on the #12, #13 and #68 bus lines (on Capitol Way).
