Thurston's Hunger Walk

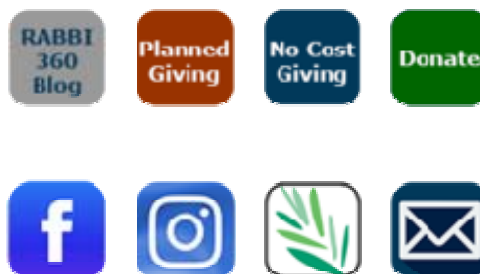
Sunday, September 22, 3:00 pm
