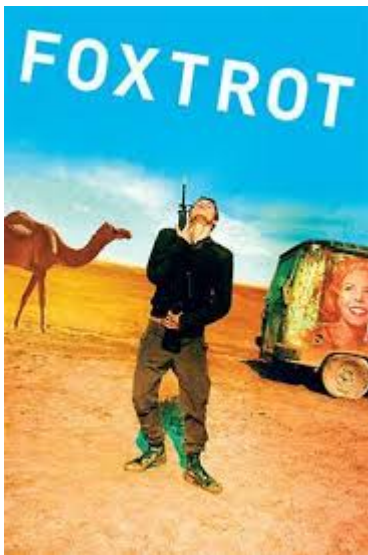

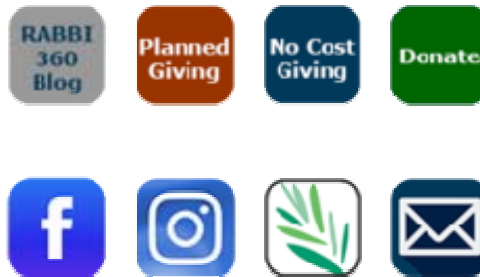
World Zionist Congress Elections
