#### Tot Shabbat, 9:30 am

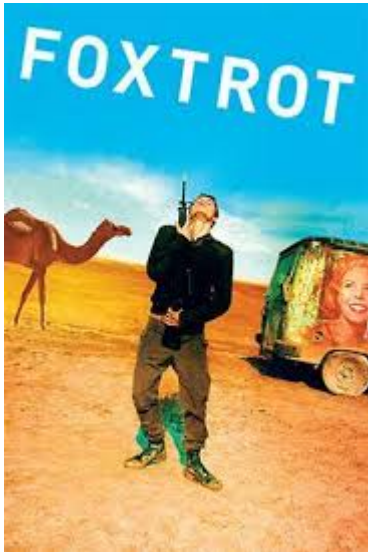
