

Satellite Lots

Upon departing Temple Sinai, buses will load at specific locations on the Sinai campus assigned to each of the satellite parking lots. Please make note of the name and color of the parking lot in which you have parked. When services end, please follow the signs located throughout the building and on the sidewalks to the bus loading area that corresponds to your parking lot. Please remain on the sidewalk at all times.

E-Parking Passes or Pick Up

Only those with e-parking passes or waiting to be picked up will exit via front doors of the building to await for their car.

All individuals will be required to park in satellite parking lots and take the shuttle to Temple Sinai, unless you qualify for an e-parking pass.
