



Join the fight to protect the Okefenokee

1. Tell Your Legislators to Support House Bill 71.

If passed, the Okefenokee Protection Act (House Bill 71) will prevent future mining along Trail Ridge near the Okefenokee. The bill has received robust bipartisan support, with 42 co-signers to date.

2. Urge the EPD to Reject Twin Pines' Draft Mining Proposal

Georgia's Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is currently reviewing Twin Pines' proposed draft mining land use plan. If approved, the company would be allowed to proceed with permitting for this dangerous mine, destroying more than 300 acres of wetlands and causing air, light and water pollution.
