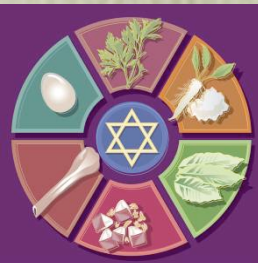

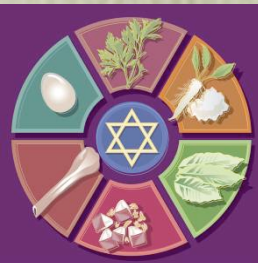
## One Small Step

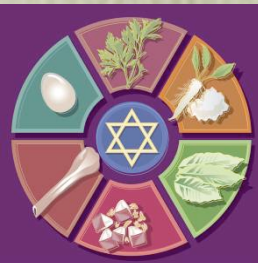

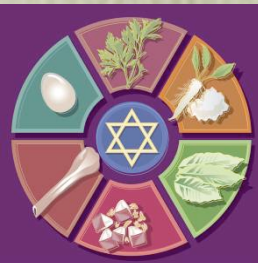

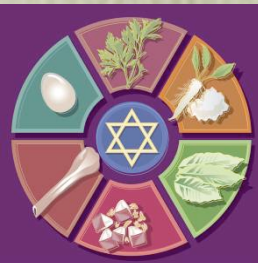
