Hebrew will be taught in a new web-based format called Shalom Learning. The program is interactive and allows for students to progress at their own pace. It will not eliminate teachers, but make it easier for students who miss class. Level 3, for grades 6 and 7 will be a conversational Hebrew class while grades 2-5 will focus on prayer mastery.
