Rabbi's Message

This Shabbos we read from two Torahs. The first is the weekly Parsha of Ki Sisa and the second is Parshas Para and the halachos of the Para Aduma - the Red Heifer. This totally red heifer was burned, its ashes mixed with special water and sprinkled by a kohen on a person who was ritually impure. They were cleansed from their contamination. It is remarkable that we read davka on this Shabbos about a curing potion for a contaminated individual. Oh if only we had such a vaccination for the coronavirus!

As I am sure you all are aware this virus is spreading throughout the world and some communities are taking drastic measures to contain it. The population at most risk are seniors. We must be vigilant and protect our health and the wellbeing of others. Therefore:

- If you have any compromised respiratory issues - stay at home - do not come to shul.
If you are coughing - stay at home - do not come to shul.
Wash your hands often, plain soap and water are very effective.
Drink plenty of water.
Follow your doctor's instructions!

YIDB has instituted some protective measures for our safety.

- Do not kiss the Mezuzah, just look respectfully as you pass it.
Do not kiss the Torah, just look respectfully as it passes by.
Do not shake hands.
There will be no Seudas Shlishi in shul.
No Tikun in shul.

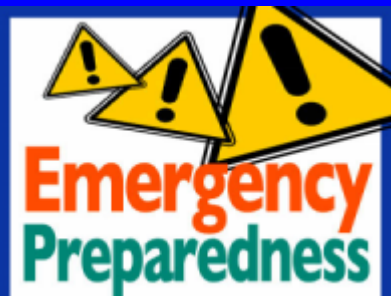
