KIDDUSH & SEUDAH SHLISHIT MENU

1. **Hashkama Minyan Kiddush –Cost: \$150.00.** Includes tuna fish, herring, crackers, pareve cakes, assorted chips and pretzels, assorted regular and diet soda, seltzer, water, coffee, tea and all paper goods.
2. **Basic Kiddush – Cost: \$350.00.** Includes 2 trays of meat chulent, tuna fish, herring, assorted vegetables, crackers, pareve cakes, assorted chips and pretzels, hummus, salsa, Kedem grape juice, assorted regular and diet soda, seltzer, water, coffee, tea and all paper goods. Basic kiddush will feed approximately 180 people.
3. **Seudah Shlishit –Cost: \$150.00.** Includes rolls, tuna fish, smoked fish, crackers, pareve cakes, assorted chips and pretzels, assorted regular and diet soda, seltzer, water, coffee, tea and all paper goods. Should the Seudah Shlishit be a sponsored event where the sponsor invites private guests (i.e. Sheva Brachot, etc.) the sponsor will be charged \$100 per 25 people for any additional set up required, as well as any additional food preparation required to accommodate additional guests:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In addition, sponsors may provide additional food (e.g., cholent, kugels, salads, desserts) from an acceptable caterer and/or vendor at their own cost. **Please note that any additional food items brought into the Shul must comply with the Shul's food allergy guidelines.** Sponsors are responsible for contacting the caterer and/or vendor and paying them directly for the additional items added to supplement the basic menu. Sponsors may also add to the Kiddush by bringing in liquor, as well as other food items that are **closed and sealed** and bear one of the acceptable kosher symbols (i.e. additional cakes, cookies, salads, etc.). If you have any questions about a specific Kashrus agency, please contact the Rabbi and/or someone from the Kashrus Committee. All such items that are brought in at the cost of the Sponsor will put out by the Shul's kiddush staff. Please be aware that arrangements need to be made with the Rabbi, or in his absence, the Kashrus Committee representative to check these items for approval and provide proper storage for the food in the appropriate kitchen.

The costs above does **not** include additional setup of round tables and chairs for seating. Round and long tables already set up for a standard kiddush, whether sponsored or unsponsored, are to accommodate the elderly only.

Please note any decorative tablecloths, specials items, including decorations, provided by the host must be set up by the host prior to the event.

A contract must be completed, signed and submitted with payment in full to the shul office.
