The Shofar and the School Bell

The Hebrew month of Elul brings with it the tradition of the Shofar. Traditionally, we hear the Shofar blast each and every morning of Elul leading up to the High Holidays, except

for Shabbat morning. Each year, I try to consider the emotion of the Shofar. Does it sound sad or happy? How does it make us all feel?

This year I'd like to relate it to the school bell. The school bell was a mechanical sound that was always the same. It said get up, move on, change classes, eventually return home. The school bell was a part of my life for many years—so much so, that I never stopped to consider it.

I fear that, for many of us, the Shofar blasts are such a spectacle that all we do is stand in awe, but in fact we don't hear its message: get up, move on, change, and return. There is a utilitarian usage to the Shofar, much like the school bell, but it seems to get lost in the majesty.

So this year, let's focus on the action of the ringing blast. How do I stand up from wherever I am relaxing? Where should I go next? Where is the eventual home that I am going? And when we get there, we can go back to considering our feelings.
