ISJL Hospitality Request

Dr. Josh Parshall, the Director of the History Department at the Institute of Southern Jewish Life (ISJL) will be leading a research trip to North Florida. The research will support their work on the Florida section of the ISJL online [Encyclopedia of Southern Jewish Communities](#), which already contains over 200 entries on local Jewish history in the region. He will be traveling to Tallahassee in July with two summer interns. They will be on the road for about a week, visiting Pensacola, Ft. Walton Beach, Panama City Beach, Tallahassee, and one or two other towns.

Dr. Parshall and his colleagues usually rely on home hospitality for their summer research trips in order to keep travel costs down, and because their hosts give them helpful insights into the local Jewish community.

They will be in Tallahassee for two nights (tentatively July 11 and 12), and are looking for 2-3 rooms. Guests will be Dr. Parshall, one male intern, and one female intern. They do not have to be housed in the same location, should you only have space for one.
