Borei P'ri Hagafen

This prayer is said after lighting the candles on Shabbat.

Borei P'ri Hagafen means creator of the fruit of the vine.

Shabbat is a special day for relaxation and spending time with family. There are three blessings we use to welcome Shabbat. The third blessing, Kiddush is said over wine. The name Kiddush comes from the word that means “making holy”. This blessing helps us symbolize Shabbat’s holiness. This is the first blessing of the two blessings that make up the Kiddush. You will learn the second blessing for your black dog tag.
