Hamotzi

Hamotzi comes after the candle blessing and the wine blessing on Shabbat.

Hamotzi means to bring forth. Another important word in this prayer is lechem which means bread.

Shabbat is a special day for relaxation and spending time with family. There are three blessings we use to welcome Shabbat. The second blessing is hamotzi which we say over the braided challah representing our appreciation for the food we are about to eat.
