



Dear Members and Friends,

We hope that you and your family are doing well. During this trying time the Minyan is having zoom shiurim and is planning for the Yomim Noraim and the upcoming year! Rosh Hashana begins Friday night September 18th. Please take this time to renew your Minyan Membership and to reserve seats for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

As we all know, things are very different now than in past years. The shul will be setup for social distancing and we require masks to be worn for the entire tefillah. We plan to have two concurrent minyanim. One will be downstairs and one will be upstairs. Seating is limited to about 40 people at each minyan. The morning davening will be shorter than normal. We will start at Nishmas and there will be less singing than usual. We understand that not everyone is ready to daven inside and therefore we will have an outdoor shofar blowing on Sunday.
